

## Short Biography

Alessandro Sembenelli

Alessandro Sembenelli is full professor at the Faculty of Economics of the University of Turin, Deputy Director and Research Fellow at Collegio Carlo Alberto and 2011 President of the Italian Econometric Society. He obtained his PhD from the University of East Anglia. His research interests lie at the interface between applied micro-econometrics, industrial organization and corporate finance with a strong focus on the application of panel data econometric techniques to firm level data. In particular he has contributed to the literature on mark-up, investment and dividend policies; diversification and multinationality; R&D, innovation and productivity; venture capital and entry; labor demand; offshoring and migration. On these issues he has published in leading international journals including the *European Economic Review*, the *International Journal of Industrial Organization*, the *Review of Economics and Statistics*, the *Journal of Financial Economics*, the *Journal of International Economics*, the *Journal of the European Economic Association* and the *Journal of Public Economics*. He is a former member of the Executive Committee of EARIE (European Association for Research in Industrial Organization) and of the SIE (Italian Economic Society) Committee on Research and Research Evaluation, a former Director of the Department of Economics "G. Prato" and a current member of CIDE (Interuniversity Centre for Econometrics) Executive Committee. He has acted as scientific coordinator or consultant in several international research projects sponsored by international organizations including the EU Commission, the World Bank and the Banque de France.
